applicant's application has been made. The department shall 1 2 make such rules as are necessary for the orderly processing of 3 driver license applications. Each such application shall include a consent to 4 (3) 5 release driving record information, which requires entitling the department to request, receive, and exchange such 6 7 information with other jurisdictions. 8 The department may require applicants for a driver (8) 9 license to submit fingerprints by means of an inkless 10 fingerprint scanning device at the time of application. 11 Section 2.
