terminated pursuant to Section 19(f), Article III of the State Constitution on November 4, 2000, is re-created. (2) All current balances of the Alcoholic Beverage and Tobacco Trust Fund within the Department of Business and Professional Regulation are carried forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust fund are continued.
