Remove from the bill: Everything after the enacting clause
and insert in lieu thereof:

Section 1. The Board of Pharmacy shall conduct a study on the issue of licensure by endorsement for pharmacists in this state. In conducting its study, the board shall review issues including, but not limited to, the following: impacts on employment of pharmacists currently practicing in this state; impacts on the colleges of pharmacy located in this state, including employment opportunities for currently enrolled students; and differences in the training, education, and continuing education of pharmacists licensed outside this state. The board shall seek input from all interested parties, including, but not limited to, currently licensed pharmacists, owners of pharmacies, manufacturers, wholesalers, and any other person involved in the distribution of pharmaceutical drugs in this state. Staffing for the study and any costs involved shall be borne by the board. The board shall submit a
