(1) The Intangible Tax Trust Fund within the Department of Revenue, FLAIR number 73-2-399, which was 23 created by section 199.292, Florida Statutes, and which is to 24 25 be terminated pursuant to Section 19(f), Article III of the 26 State Constitution on November 4, 2000, is re-created. 27 (2) All current balances of the trust fund are carried 28 forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust fund 29 are continued. 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect November 4, 31 2000.
