The annual use fees shall be distributed annually 1 (b) 2 to each county in the ratio that the annual use fees collected 3 by each county bears to the total fees collected for the 4 plates within the state. Each county shall distribute the funds to nongovernmental, not-for-profit agencies within the 5 county, which agencies' services provide counseling and 6 7 meeting the physical needs of pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for adoption. Funds may be 8 distributed to any certified agency that is involved or 9 10 associated with promoting adoption or foster care. 11 1. Agencies that receive the funds must use at least 12 70 percent of the funds to provide for the material needs of 13 pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for adoption, including clothing, housing, medical care, food, 14 15 utilities, and transportation. Such funds may also be expended on infants awaiting placement with adoptive parents. 16 17 2. The remaining funds may be used for adoption, 18 counseling, training, or advertising, but may not be used for administrative expenses, legal expenses, or capital 19 20 expenditures. 3. Funds may not be distributed to any agency which 21 has one or more owners, board members, or employees who have 22 been convicted of a misdemeanor or felony involving activity 23 relating to an abortion provider, staff member of an abortion 24 25 provider, or physician who performs abortions; nor may funds be distributed to any agency which has one or more owners, 26 27 board members, or employees who have been enjoined from activity relating to an abortion provider, staff member of an 28 29 abortion provider, or physician who performs abortions. 4. Each agency that receives such funds must submit an 30 31 annual audit, prepared by a certified public accountant, to 2
