(1) The Rehabilitation Administrative 26 Expense Fund within the Department of Insurance, FLAIR number 27 46-2-582, which was created by section 641.227, Florida 28 Statutes, and which is to be terminated pursuant to Section 19(f), Article III of the State Constitution on November 4, 29 30 2000, is re-created. 31
