(1) The Displaced Homemaker Trust Fund 28 within the Department of Education, Division of Community Colleges, FLAIR number 48-2-160, which is created by section 29 30 446.50, Florida Statutes, and which is to be terminated 31

pursuant to Section 19(f), Article III of the State Constitution on November 4, 2000, is re-created. (2) All current balances of the trust fund are carried forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust fund are continued. Section 2. This act shall take effect November 4, 2000.
