A bill to be entitled  
An act relating to clean indoor air; amending  
s. 386.202, F.S.; providing legislative intent  
that the "Florida Clean Indoor Air Act" is a  
uniform statewide minimum code; repealing s.  
386.209, F.S., which provides that the  
regulation of smoking is preempted to the  
state; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 386.202, Florida Statutes, is  
amended to read:

386.202 Legislative intent.--The purpose of this part  
is to protect the public health, comfort, and environment by  
creating areas in public places and at public meetings that  
are reasonably free from tobacco smoke by providing a uniform  
statewide minimum ~~maximum~~ code. This part shall not be  
interpreted to require the designation of smoking areas.  
However, it is the intent of the Legislature to discourage the  
designation of any area within a government building as a  
smoking area.

Section 2. Section 386.209, Florida Statutes, is  
repealed.

Section 3. This act shall take effect October 1, 1999.

SENATE SUMMARY

Provides legislative intent that the "Florida Clean  
Indoor Air Act" is a uniform statewide minimum code  
rather than maximum code. Repeals the preemption of the  
regulation of smoking to the state.
