301-152-99 A bill to be entitled 1 2 An act relating to the re-creation of the 3 University of Florida Health Center Incidental Trust Fund without modification; re-creating 4 5 the University of Florida Health Center 6 Incidental Trust Fund; carrying forward current 7 balances and continuing current sources and uses thereof; providing an effective date. 8 9 10 WHEREAS, the Legislature wishes to extend the life of the University of Florida Health Center Incidental Trust Fund, 11 12 which is otherwise scheduled to be terminated pursuant to constitutional mandate, and 13 WHEREAS, the Legislature has reviewed the University of 14 Florida Health Center Incidental Trust Fund before its 15 16 scheduled termination date and has found that it continues to 17 meet an important public purpose, and WHEREAS, the Legislature has found that existing public 18 19 policy concerning the University of Florida Health Center 20 Incidental Trust Fund sets adequate parameters for its use, NOW, THEREFORE, 21 22 23 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 24 25 Section 1. (1) The University of Florida Health 26 Center Incidental Trust Fund, FLAIR number 49-2-381, which was 27 created within the Department of Education and which is to be 28 terminated pursuant to Section 19(f), Article III of the State Constitution on November 4, 2000, is re-created. 29 30 31
