(1) The Ecosystem Management and Restoration Trust Fund, FLAIR number 37-2-193, which was 23 created within the Department of Environmental Protection and 24 25 which is to be terminated pursuant to Section 19(f), Article 26 III of the State Constitution on July 1, 2000, is re-created. 27 (2) All current balances of the trust fund are carried 28 forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust fund 29 are continued. 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000. 31 1
