(1) The State Park Trust Fund within the 21 Department of Environmental Protection, FLAIR number 37-2-675, 22 which is to be terminated pursuant to Section 19(f), Article III of the State Constitution on November 4, 2000, is 23 24 re-created. 25 (2) All current balances of the trust fund are carried 26 forward and all current sources and uses of the trust fund are 27 continued. 28 Section 2. This act shall take effect November 4, 29 2000. 30 31 1
