However, except for premises licensed on or before July 1, 1999, a location for 23 on-premises consumption of alcoholic beverages may not be 24 25 located within 500 feet of the real property that comprises a 26 public or private elementary school, middle school, or 27 secondary school unless the county or municipality approves 28 the location as promoting the public health, safety, and 29 general welfare of the community under proceedings as provided in s. 286.0115. location unless the licensee provides documentation of proper zoning from the appropriate county or municipal zoning authorities. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1999. SENATE SUMMARY Provides that a location for on-premises consumption of alcoholic beverages licensed after July 1, 1999, may not be located within 500 feet of a school unless the county or municipal government approves the location under quasi-judicial procedures used for other zoning decisions.
