19	(1) A person who knows that a crime which exposes the
20	victim to serious bodily injury is being committed must report
21	the crime to a law enforcement officer as soon as it is
22	reasonably practicable, to the extent that report can be made
23	without danger to the person reporting or to another person.
24	Any person who violates this subsection commits a misdemeanor
25	of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or
26	<u>s. 775.083.</u>
27	(2) This section may not be construed to apply to a
28	person either who is prosecuted as a principal in the first
29	degree or an accessory after the fact to an offense, or who is
30	prosecuted for attempting, soliciting, or conspiring to commit
