The Legislature further finds that the exemption provided for 25 in this act is a public necessity because the public 26 27 disclosure of sensitive information as well as information otherwise confidential or exempt could lead to discrimination 28 29 against affected persons and could make these persons 30 reluctant to seek assistance for themselves or their family

This result would then negatively affect the

effective and efficient operation of the Statewide Public Guardianship Office.

(2) The Legislature finds that the exemption in subsection (2) of section 1 of this act is a public necessity because the disclosure of sensitive information about an appointed or prospective guardian's credit history and background could hinder the recruitment of quardians and make persons who would otherwise serve reluctant to assume the role of guardians. This result would then negatively affect the operation of the Statewide Public Guardianship Program.

Section 3. This act shall take effect on the same date that Senate Bill 702 or similar legislation creating the Statewide Public Guardianship Office takes effect, if such legislation is adopted in the same legislative session or an extension thereof.
