Florida Commission on Federal and State Agricultural Relations. --11 12 (1)(a) There is created within the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services the Florida Commission on 13 Federal and State Agricultural Relations composed of 16 14 members. Two members shall be members of the Florida Senate 15 appointed by the President of the Senate; three members shall 16 be members of the Florida House of Representatives appointed 17 by the Speaker of the House of Representatives; two members 18 19 shall be members of Congress appointed by the Commissioner of Agriculture. The President of the Senate, the Speaker of the 20 House of Representatives, the Governor, and the Commissioner 21 22 of Agriculture shall each appoint two residents of the state who are engaged in the agriculture business, and each 23 appointing authority shall consult with all the other 24 25 appointing authorities to make certain that a diversity of 26 agricultural business interests are represented on the 27 commission. The resident agricultural members shall be 28 appointed to 4-year terms. A vacancy will be filled in the same manner as the original appointment. The Commissioner of 29 30 Agriculture shall serve as chairperson of the Commission. 31

2	be reimbursed for per diem and travel expenses in accordance

4	(2) The commission shall coordinate efforts to
5	maximize federal funds for Florida agricultural purposes.
6	Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
