LEGISLATIVE SUMMARY Requires the Department of Law Enforcement to provide to public defenders on-line access to criminal records not exempt from disclosure or confidential under law, such access to be used only in support of the duties of a public defender or of any attorney specially assigned in the representation of any person who is determined indigent. Requires the costs of such access to be borne by the office provided access. See bill for details.
