19	Section 2. <u>Effective September 1, 1999, the College of</u>		
20	<u>Arts and Sciences at the Florida State University is</u>		
21	<u>abolished. The College of Arts and Sciences at the Florida</u>		
22	<u>Agricultural and Mechanical University shall be reconstituted</u>		
23	<u>as a joint program to serve students at both institutions.</u>		
24	<u>However, the joint program shall be administered by the</u>		
25	<u>Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University.</u>		
26	<u>(1) Employees of the College of Arts and Sciences at</u>		
27	<u>the Florida State University may be considered for</u>		
28	<u>reemployment at the reconstituted program. Employees who are</u>		
29	<u>not selected for reemployment shall be considered laid off</u>		
30	<u>under the provisions of Article 13 of the State University</u>		
31	<u>System's Collective Bargaining Agreement.</u>

1 (2) Real property and facilities owned by the Florida
2 State University and used exclusively to conduct programs
