A student shall be 17 classified as matriculated and degree-seeking if the student: 18 19 (a) Is not enrolled in a program of advanced placement 20 or early admission; 21 (b) Has met the testing requirements of section 22 240.117, Florida Statutes; and 23 (c) Has been classified by the community college as a matriculated, degree-seeking student. 24 25 (2) The community college shall use the classification of students as matriculated and degree-seeking for reports 26 27 required by section 240.324, Florida Statutes, the community 28 college accountability process. A student may maintain the 29 status of a degree-seeking student for other purposes, such as 30 eligibility for financial aid, even if the college has not
