A bill to be entitled

An act relating to district school boards;
amending s. 230.04, F.S.; allowing a school
board member to be referred to by the term
"commissioner"; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 230.04, Florida Statutes, is
amended to read:

230.04 Membership of school board.--The school board
in each district shall be composed of not less than five
members. Each member of the school board shall be a qualified
elector of the district in which she or he serves, shall be a
resident of the school board member residence area from which
she or he is elected, and shall maintain such ~~said~~ residency
throughout her or his term of office. The term "commissioner"
may be used in addressing or referring to a school board
member.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1999.

SENATE SUMMARY

Allows district school board members to be referred to as
commissioners.
