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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. Pursuant to chapter 97-255, Laws of Florida, this act constitutes the codification of all special acts relating to the East Charlotte Drainage District. It is the intent of the Legislature in enacting this law to provide a single, comprehensive special act charter for the district, including all current legislative authority granted to the district by its several legislative enactments and any additional authority granted by this act.

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Section 2. <u>Chapter 65-664, Laws of Florida, chapter 80-472, Laws of Florida, chapter 85-395, Laws of Florida, and paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section 1 of chapter </u>

Charter Amendments. -- The district's charter may be amended only by special act of the Legislature. 24 25 Governing Body. -- In accordance with Section 9. chapter 189, Florida Statutes, this act, and section 298.11, 26 Florida Statutes, the district is governed by a three-member 27 28 board, elected on a one-acre, one-vote basis by the landowners 29 in the district. The membership and organization of the board 30 shall be as set forth in this act and chapter 298, Florida Statutes, as they may be amended from time to time. 31
