This act shall take effect July 1, 1999. 21 22 23 HOUSE SUMMARY 24 With respect to chapter 255, F.S., relating to public property and publicly owned buildings, revises current provisions of law to authorize, rather than require, that each appropriation for the original construction of a state building which provides public access include an amount of up to 0.25 percent, rather than 0.5 percent as is currently provided, of the total appropriation for the construction of the building, not to exceed \$50,000, rather than \$100,000 as is currently provided, to be used for the acquisition of works of art produced by, but not limited to, Florida artists or craftspersons. 25 26 27 28 29
