16	(1) A carrier shall limit disclosure of health
17	information, consistent with an individual's request, if the
18	individual clearly states in writing that disclosure to
19	specified persons of all or part of such information could
20	jeopardize the individual's safety.
21	(2) A carrier shall disclose health information
22	pursuant to a subpoena or court order issued after the court's
23	determination that the public interest in disclosure outweighs
24	the individual's privacy interest and that the health
25	information is not reasonably available by other means.
26	(3) For purposes of this section:
27	(a) "Carrier" means any person or entity licensed in
28	this state under chapter 624, chapter 626, chapter 636, or

behalf of a carrier which relates to any physical, mental, or behavioral health or condition of an individual or any member of the individual's family or the provision of or payment for health care to an individual and which identifies such individual or which could be used to identify such individual. For purposes of this act, the term "individual" means a person who is the subject of such health information. Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 1999. HOUSE SUMMARY Limits disclosure of health information by carriers if requested by an individual to protect his or her safety. Provides for disclosure pursuant to subpoena or court order.
