23	materials, equipment, and other items <u>or the license in or</u>		
24	<u>lease of real property</u> by any entity, institution, or		
25	organization that is primarily engaged in teaching students to		
26	perform any of the activities or services described in s.		
27	212.031(1)(a)9., that conducts classes at a fixed location		
28	located in this state, that is licensed under chapter 246, and		
29	that has at least 500 enrolled students. Any entity,		
30	institution, or organization meeting the requirements of this		
31	section shall be deemed to qualify for the exemptions in ss.
