22	<u>center means a non-profit organization, recognized under</u>		
23	<u>section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, that is a full</u>		
24	<u>member of the Association of Science and Technology Centers,</u>		
25	<u>is accredited by the American Association of Museums, and has</u>		
26	<u>had at least 5 years experience providing professional</u>		
27	<u>development and support services to teachers throughout the</u>
