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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. Section 409.26731, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

409.26731 Certification of local funds as state match for federally funded services; federal waivers. -- In order to implement Specific Appropriations 330 and 334 through 352 of the 1997-1998 General Appropriations Act, The Department of Children and Family Services is authorized to annually certify local funds not to exceed \$5 million as state match for children's mental health services funded by Medicaid in excess of the amount of state general revenue matching funds appropriated for such services through the 1997-1998 General Appropriations Act. The department is also authorized to annually certify local funds not to exceed \$5 million as state match for eligible Title IV-E services for children under the supervision or and custody of the state in excess of the amount of state general revenue matching funds appropriated for such services by the 1997-1998 General Appropriations Act in Specific Appropriations 334 through 352. Federal Medicaid or Title IV-E funds provided to the state as federal financial 31 participation consequent to certified local matching funds

shall automatically be passed through to the local jurisdiction that provided the certified local match. All of the provisions of this section are based upon federal approval of the provisions as specifically limited in this section and shall not become effective if any further modifications are required of the state. The Agency for Health Care Administration is authorized to apply for federal waivers to modify the state Medicaid plan to include optional Medicaid in-home and therapeutic services for Medicaid-eligible children if the state match for such services is provided by local funds certified by the department as state match. Such services shall be available only in communities that provide the certified match.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

Authorizes the Department of Children and Family Services to annually certify local funds for state match for certain federally funded services for children who are either under the supervision of or in the custody of the department. Current law provides such funding pursuant to a specific appropriation and only for children who are both under the supervision of and in the custody of the department.
