Section 25.403, Florida Statutes, is created to read: 18 19 25.403 Small County Courthouse Facilities Trust 20 Fund.--21 (1)(a) The trust fund moneys in the Small Counties 22 Courthouse Facilities Trust Fund, administered by the Supreme 23 Court, must be used to compensate counties for the costs they incur for consulting or architectural studies related to the 24 25 improvement of courthouse facilities, improving court facilities to assure compliance with the American with 26 27 Disabilities Act and other federal and state requirements, and 28 other renovations in court facilities, including improvements 29 in court security. (b) The Supreme Court shall adopt an allocation and 30 disbursement plan for the operation of the trust fund and the 31 1

1 expenditure of moneys deposited in the trust fund. The Supreme Court shall include the plan in its legislative budget 2 3 request. The plan shall include evaluation criteria used to measure each county request. A committee of nine people shall 4 5 develop and recommend the allocation and disbursement plan to б the Supreme Court. The committee shall be composed of: Three persons appointed by the Florida Association 7 1. 8 of Counties who must reside in counties with populations of less than 75,000; 9 10 2. Three persons appointed by the Chief Justice of the 11 Supreme Court who must reside in counties with populations of less than 75,000; and 12 13 Three persons appointed by the Florida Association 3. of Court Clerks and Comptrollers who must reside in counties 14 with populations of less than 75,000. 15 (C) Amendments to the approved operating budget for 16 17 expenditures from the Small Counties Courthouse Facilities Trust Fund must be approved in accordance with the provisions 18 19 of s. 216.181. The total amount disbursed from the Small Counties Courthouse Facilities Trust Fund may not exceed the 20 21 amount authorized by the General Appropriations Act.
