This act shall take effect October 1, 1999. 26 *********** 27 28 HOUSE SUMMARY 29 Requires health care practitioners to report to the county sheriff any treatment or request for treatment of a gunshot wound or life-threatening injury indicating an act of violence. Provides a first degree misdemeanor 30 penalty for failure to so report.
