Court costs imposed under this subsection may not exceed \$30. A criminal justice selection center or other local criminal justice access and assessment center may be funded from these court costs when authorized by the chief judge of the judicial circuit. б Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1999. ****** SENATE SUMMARY Authorizes the chief judge of a judicial circuit to direct that court costs assessed under s. 318.18(11), F.S., be used to fund a criminal justice selection center or other local criminal justice access and assessment center.
