However, enforcement of this section by state 18 or local law enforcement agencies must be accomplished only as 19 a secondary action when a driver of a motor vehicle has been 20 detained for a suspected violation of another section of this 21 chapter, chapter 320, or chapter 322. 22 Section 2.
