and insert:

(3)(a) Any information that would reveal the name, address, or telephone number of, or information that would identify any of the deceased's surviving siblings, family members, or others living in the home in reports or records created by the State Child Abuse Death Review Committee or local committee, or a panel or committee assembled by the state committee or a local committee pursuant to s. 383.402 which relates solely to child fatalities and in which specific persons or incidents are discussed is confidential and exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution.

(b) Portions of meetings or proceedings of the State Child Abuse Death Review Committee or local committee, or a panel or committee assembled by the state committee or a local

1 committee pursuant to s. 383.402 which relate solely to child
2 fatalities and in which specific persons or incidents are
3 discussed are confidential and exempt from s. 286.011 and s.
4 24(b), Art. I of the State Constitution. The state committee

6 discuss nonconfidential information or issues.

7 (4) All information and records acquired by the State
8 Child Abuse Death Review Committee or a local committee are
9 confidential and not subject to subpoena, discovery, or
10 introduction into evidence in any civil or criminal
