A bill to be entitled
An act relating to persons sentenced to death;
providing that a person sentenced to death may
not marry; authorizing the Department of
Corrections to adopt rules implementing the
prohibition with respect to inmates in the
custody of the department; providing an
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Certain marriages prohibited.--A person who
is under a sentence of death in this state may not marry. The
Department of Corrections may adopt rules to implement this
section with respect to inmates in the custody of the
department.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1999.

SENATE SUMMARY

Prohibits a person sentenced to death from marrying.
Authorizes the Department of Corrections to adopt rules
to implement the prohibition.
