I. SUMMARY:

This bill provides correction of a scrivener's error in a previous special act to accurately reflect the administration of examination certification for plumbing contractors in Pinellas County.

II. SUBSTANTIVE ANALYSIS:

A. PRESENT SITUATION:

Various examination committees within the Pinellas County Construction Licensing Board are responsible for conducting examinations for contractor certification in Pinellas County. Such powers were granted to them in chapter 89-504, Laws of Florida. An internal audit by the Pinellas County Clerk of the Court identified an error in the special act which authorized the examination committee for *plumbing* certification to conduct exams for *electrical* contractors instead of *plumbing* contractors.

This bill provides correction of a scrivener's error in a previous special act to accurately reflect the administration of examination certification for plumbing contractors in Pinellas County.
