Section 316.211, Florida Statutes, is 10 amended to read: 316.211 Equipment for motorcycle and moped riders .--11 12 No person shall operate or ride upon a motorcycle (1)unless the person is properly wearing protective headgear 13 securely fastened upon his or her head which complies with 14 15 standards established by the department. (2) No person shall operate a motorcycle unless the 16 17 person is wearing an eye-protective device over his or her eyes of a type approved by the department. 18 19 (3) This section does shall not apply to persons 20 riding within an enclosed cab, or to any person 16 years of 21 age or older who is operating or riding upon a motorcycle 22 powered by a motor that has with a displacement of 50 cubic centimeters or less, that or is rated not in excess of 2 brake 23 24 horsepower, and that which is not capable of propelling such 25 motorcycle at a speed greater than 30 miles per hour on level 26 ground, or to any person 21 years of age or older. 27 No person under 16 years of age shall operate or (4) 28 ride upon a moped unless the person is properly wearing protective headgear securely fastened upon his or her head 29 30 which complies with standards established by the department. 31
