insert: Section 1. Short title.--This act may be cited as the "Entertainment Florida Act of 1999."

Section 2. Legislative findings and intent.--The Legislature finds that the entertainment industry is comprised of multiple components, including, but not limited to, the operation of motion picture or television studios; the production of motion pictures, made-for-TV motion pictures, televisions series, commercial advertising, music videos, and sound recordings; the attendance at, participation in, and hosting of professional and amateur sporting events; and the attendance by in-state and out-of-state visitors at commercial and other attractions in the state. The Legislature further finds that these interrelated components form an entertainment industry cluster with the potential to contribute significantly to the efforts of the state to develop its economy and create employment opportunities for its residents.

1 It is the intent of the Legislature to recognize the economic
2 development significance of the entertainment industry and to
3 adopt policies designed to facilitate its growth.
