Section 316.2122, Florida Statutes, is created to read: 15 316.2122 Operation of a low-speed vehicle on certain 16 17 roadways. -- The operation of a low-speed vehicle, as defined in s. 320.01(42), upon the public roads or streets of this state 18 19 is authorized with the following restrictions: 20 (1) A low-speed vehicle may be operated only on streets where the posted speed limit is 35 miles per hour or 21 22 less. This does not prohibit a low-speed vehicle from crossing 23 a road or street at an intersection where the road or street has a posted speed limit of more than 35 miles per hour. 24 25 (2) A low-speed vehicle must be equipped with headlamps, stop lamps, turn signal lamps, taillamps, reflex 26 27 reflectors, parking brakes, rearview mirrors, windshields, 28 seat belts, and vehicle identification numbers. 29 (3) A low-speed vehicle must be registered and insured in accordance with s. 320.02. 30 31

Subsection (22) of section 320.01, Florida 12 Statutes, is amended and subsection (42) is added to that 13 section to read: 14 320.01 Definitions, general.--As used in the Florida 15 Statutes, except as otherwise provided, the term: 16 (22) "Golf cart" means a motor vehicle that is 17 18 designed and manufactured for operation on a golf course for 19 sporting or recreational purposes and that is not capable of exceeding speeds of 20 miles per hour. 20 (42) "Low-speed vehicle" means any four-wheeled 21 electric vehicle whose top speed is greater than 20 miles per 22 hour but not greater than 25 miles per hour, including 23 24 neighborhood electric vehicles. Low-speed vehicles must comply 25 with the safety standards in 49 C.F.R. 571.500 and s. 316.2122. 26
