(1) Each blueprint of an educational 15 facility as defined in section 235.011(6), Florida Statutes, 16 and each blueprint of a state university facility that is 17 submitted to a law enforcement agency, the Department of 18 Education, or the State Board of Education, as required by 19 Committee Substitute for Senate Bills 852, 2, and 46, 2000 20 Regular Session, is confidential and exempt from section 21 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and Section 24(a), Article I of 22 the State Constitution. This exemption is subject to the Open Government Sunset Review Act of 1995 in accordance with 23 section 119.15, Florida Statutes, and shall stand repealed on 24 October 2, 2005, unless reviewed and saved from repeal through 25 26 reenactment by the Legislature. 27 (2) Portions of all meetings or proceedings of any 28 agency as defined in section 119.011(2), Florida Statutes, 29 relating directly to, or that would reveal confidential and

exempt information relating solely to, the blueprints of an educational facility or of a state university facility are

confidential and exempt from section 286.011, Florida

Statutes, and Section 24(b), Article I of the State

Constitution. An agency as defined in section 119.011(2),

Florida Statutes, may hold public meetings to discuss

nonconfidential information or issues relating to these

blueprints.

- rule the information relating to the blueprints of an educational facility, as defined in section 235.011(6), Florida Statutes, which is confidential and exempt from the provisions of section 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and Section 24(a), Article I of the State Constitution. To be confidential, the information must be necessary to the security and integrity of the educational facility.
- (4) The Board of Regents shall prescribe by rule the information relating to the blueprints of a state university facility which is confidential and exempt from the provisions of section 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and Section 24(a), Article I of the State Constitution. To be confidential, the information must be necessary to the security and integrity of the state university facility.
- (5) Confidential and exempt information may be released to and used by other governmental entities as needed in connection with the performance of their duties. Any such information that is confidential and exempt as provided for in this section retains its status as confidential and exempt.

Section 2. The Legislature finds that the exemption from the public records law provided in section 1 of this act is a public necessity and that the protection of students and others in schools, community colleges, and universities is a critical state concern. Furthermore, the Legislature finds

that failure to protect the confidentiality of a blueprint of an educational facility or a state university facility submitted to or collected by law enforcement personnel, the Department of Education, or the State Board of Education under of Committee Substitute for Senate Bills 852, 2, section and 46, 2000 Regular Session, would impede the safety and security of schools, community colleges, universities, students, and others. Section 3. This act shall take effect on the effective date of Committee Substitute for Senate Bills 852, 2, and 46, 2000 Regular Session, or similar legislation relating to educational and state university facilities, and shall not take effect if that legislation does not become law. SENATE SUMMARY Provides an exemption from public records and meetings disclosure requirements for blueprints of educational and state university facilities. Provides for future review and repeal. Provides for specific rulemaking authority. Provides a finding of public necessity.
