18	Section 2. <u>(1) The State Board of Education shall</u>		
19	<u>adopt by rule uniform policies and procedures to be</u>		
20	<u>implemented if a student athlete is arrested for a crime. The</u>		
21	<u>uniform procedures shall apply to each institution in the</u>		
22	<u>State University System, each state community college, and any</u>		
23	<u>other institution of higher education that receives state</u>		
24	<u>funds. The uniform policies and procedures must be included</u>		
25	<u>in the institution's handbook, manual, or other similar</u>		
26	<u>document regularly provided to faculty and students.</u>		
27	<u>(2) As used in this section, the term "student athlete"</u>		
28	<u>means a student who participates in intercollegiate athletics</u>		
29	<u>or who has informed the institution in writing of the</u>		
30	<u>student's intent to participate in intercollegiate athletics.</u>
