In the text of any written advertisement 10 for plastic or cosmetic surgery or procedures that are 11 12 performed in a setting that is not licensed under chapter 395, Florida Statutes, whether for surgery or procedures that are 13 deemed to be elective or medically necessary, the following 14 15 statement must appear in capital letters clearly distinguishable from the rest of the text: "AS WITH ANY 16 17 SURGERY, PLASTIC OR COSMETIC SURGERY CARRIES RISKS OF UNINTENDED SERIOUS BODILY INJURY OR DEATH. CONSULT A LICENSED 18 19 PHYSICIAN CONCERNING THESE RISKS BEFORE SUBMITTING TO PLASTIC 20 OR COSMETIC SURGERY." Any advertisement that has an audible component must orally contain this statement verbatim. 21 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a 23 law. 24 25 26 SENATE SUMMARY Requires advertisements for plastic or cosmetic surgery or procedures to be conducted in an unlicensed setting to contain a specific warning of the potential dangers. 27 2.8 29 30 31 1
