A bill to be entitled

An act relating to student attendance; amending s. 236.081, F.S.; revising provisions relating to the determination of full-time equivalent membership; removing obsolete language; removing the requirement that a district's full-time equivalent membership be adjusted using the average daily attendance factor; requiring the average daily attendance factor to be used in an incentive program to maximize improvement in attendance; requiring the amount of the incentive and eligibility criteria to be annually determined by the Legislature in the General Appropriations Act; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 236.081, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

236.081 Funds for operation of schools.--If the annual allocation from the Florida Education Finance Program to each district for operation of schools is not determined in the annual appropriations act or the substantive bill implementing the annual appropriations act, it shall be determined as follows:

(1) COMPUTATION OF THE BASIC AMOUNT TO BE INCLUDED FOR OPERATION. -- The following procedure shall be followed in determining the annual allocation to each district for operation:

(a) Determination of full-time equivalent membership.--During each of several school weeks, including scheduled intersessions of a year-round school program during the fiscal year, a program membership survey of each school shall be made by each district by aggregating the full-time equivalent student membership of each program by school and by district. The department shall establish the number and interval of membership calculations, except that for basic and special programs such calculations shall not exceed nine for any fiscal year. The district's full-time equivalent membership shall be computed and currently maintained in accordance with regulations of the commissioner. Beginning with the 1999-2000 school year, Each school district shall also document the daily attendance of each student in membership by school and by district. An average daily attendance factor shall be computed by dividing the total daily attendance of all students by the total number of students in membership and then by the number of days in the regular school year. Beginning with the 2001-2002 school year, the average daily attendance factor shall be used in an incentive program to maximize improvement in attendance. The amount of the incentive and eligibility criteria are to be annually determined by the Legislature in the General Appropriations Act the district's full-time equivalent membership shall be adjusted by multiplying by the average daily attendance factor.
