- (b) The disposition of any related criminal proceedings shall not affect a suspension for refusal to submit to a blood, breath, or urine test, authorized by s. 316.1932 or s. 316.1933, imposed pursuant to this section.
- (16) The department shall invalidate a suspension for driving with an unlawful blood-alcohol level imposed pursuant
