17	capable of propelling such motorcycle at a speed greater than
18	30 miles per hour on level ground.
19	(b) Notwithstanding subsection (1), a person over 21
20	years of age may operate or ride upon a motorcycle without
21	wearing protective headgear securely fastened upon his or her
22	head if such person is covered by an insurance policy
23	providing for at least \$10,000 in medical benefits for
24	injuries incurred as a result of a crash while operating or
25	riding on a motorcycle.
