5-831-00 1 Senate Resolution No. \_\_\_\_ 2 A resolution recognizing June 2000 as Prostate 3 Cancer Awareness Month. 4 5 WHEREAS, prostate cancer is the most common type of 6 cancer among men in the United States and in Florida, and the second leading cause of cancer death among men, and 7 WHEREAS, an estimated 180,400 men in the United States 8 9 will be diagnosed with prostate cancer during 2000, and 13,700 10 of them will be residents of Florida, and WHEREAS, an estimated 31,900 men in the United States 11 12 will die from prostate cancer in 2000, and 2,400 of them will be residents of Florida, and 13 WHEREAS, men who are members of a racial minority have 14 15 a 50 percent higher risk of being diagnosed with prostate cancer, and 16 17 WHEREAS, men who are members of a racial minority and 18 who have prostate cancer are more than twice as likely to die 19 of the disease, and 20 WHEREAS, June is a month in which we commemorate men by the observance of Father's Day and of National Men's Health 21 22 Week, NOW, THEREFORE, 23 24 Be It Resolved by the Senate of the State of Florida: 25 26 That the Florida Senate recognizes June 2000 as 27 Prostate Cancer Awareness Month in Florida and urges all men, 28 and particularly members of high-risk populations, to become 29 aware of the risks and symptoms associated with prostate 30 cancer and to be informed about screening tests, methods for 31 early detection, and treatment. 1
