(2) Funds to be credited to the trust fund shall 21 22 consist of funds appropriated annually by the Legislature and as provided for by general law. Funds shall be used solely for 23 24 the purposes set forth in s. 373.4595 and for related purposes 25 undertaken pursuant to ss. 373.451-373.459. 26 (3) Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 216.301 and 27 pursuant to s. 216.351, any balance in the trust fund at the 28 end of any fiscal year shall remain in the trust fund at the

end of the year and shall be available for carrying out the

purposes of the trust fund.

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In accordance with s. 19(f)(2), Art. III of the State Constitution, the Lake Okeechobee Protection Trust Fund shall, unless terminated sooner, be terminated on July 1, 2004. Before its scheduled termination, the trust fund shall be reviewed as provided in s. 215.3206(1) and (2). Section 2.
