Department of Insurance may transfer and reassign positions as deemed necessary to effectively integrate the activities of the Division of Workers' Compensation. Appointments to time-limited positions under this act and authorized positions under this section may be made without regard to the provisions of 60K-3, 4 and 17, Florida Administrative Code. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 216.181(8), Florida Statutes, the Department of Insurance is authorized, during Fiscal Year 2000-2001, to exceed the approved salary in the budget entities affected by this act.
