Subsection (10) of section 318.21, Florida 17 Statutes, is amended to read: 318.21 Disposition of civil penalties by county 18 19 courts. -- All civil penalties received by a county court 20 pursuant to the provisions of this chapter shall be 21 distributed and paid monthly as follows: 22 (10) Twelve dollars and fifty cents from each moving 23 traffic violation must be used by the county to fund that county's participation in an intergovernmental radio 24 25 communication program approved by the Department of Management 26 Services. If the county is not participating in such a program 27 or if a municipality within the county maintains a 28 radio-communication program independent of the county, funds collected may must be used to fund local law enforcement 29 30 automation and must be distributed to the municipality or 31 special improvement district in which the violation occurred

or to the county if the violation occurred within the unincorporated area of the county. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000. SENATE SUMMARY Revises requirements for the use of funds collected from moving traffic violations within counties that do not participate in an intergovernmental radio-communication program and within counties in which a municipality maintains an independent radio-communication program.
