14 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

16           Section 1. Subsection (10) of section 318.21, Florida  
17 Statutes, is amended to read:18           318.21 Disposition of civil penalties by county  
19 courts.--All civil penalties received by a county court  
20 pursuant to the provisions of this chapter shall be  
21 distributed and paid monthly as follows:22           (10) Twelve dollars and fifty cents from each moving  
23 traffic violation must be used by the county to fund that  
24 county's participation in an intergovernmental radio  
25 communication program approved by the Department of Management  
26 Services. If the county is not participating in such a program  
27 or if a municipality within the county maintains a  
28 radio-communication program independent of the county, funds  
29 collected may ~~must~~ be used to fund local law enforcement  
30 automation and must be distributed to the municipality or  
31 special improvement district in which the violation occurred

1 or to the county if the violation occurred within the  
2 unincorporated area of the county.

3 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000.
