I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Community Resources Development Trust Fund without modification, effective November 4, 2000. The Community Resources Development Trust Fund, FLAIR #60-2-113, is administered by the Department of Children and Family Services. This fund was last re-created effective November 4, 1996, by Chapter 96-418, Laws of Florida.

II. SUBSTANTIVE ANALYSIS:

A. PRESENT SITUATION:

1. MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

Section 393.15, F.S., creates the trust fund, provides revenue sources for the fund, and defines the uses of the fund.

Section 984.22, F.S., provides a revenue source for the fund.

2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The fund is used for the purpose of granting loans to eligible programs for the initial costs of development of the programs that provide support and encouragement in the establishment of community-based foster care, group home, developmental training, and supported employment programs for persons who are developmentally disabled.

3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The major sources of revenue for the fund are child support payments for children in foster care. According to Comptroller data, receipts to this fund for FY 1998-99 were \$80.826.02.
