(1) The Department of Elderly Affairs 24 Tobacco Settlement Trust Fund within the department, FLAIR 25 26 number 65-2-122, which is to be terminated pursuant to Section 19(f), Article III of the State Constitution on July 1, 2003, 27 28 is re-created. 29 (2) All current balances of the trust fund are carried 30 forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust fund are continued. 31
