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**I. SUMMARY:**

This legislation re-creates the County Health Department Trust Fund without modification, effective November 4, 2000. The County Health Department Trust Fund, FLAIR #60-2-141, is administered by the Department of Health. This fund was last re-created effective November 4, 1996, by Chapter 96-105, Laws of Florida.

**II. SUBSTANTIVE ANALYSIS:**

**A. PRESENT SITUATION:**

**1. MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:**

Section 154.02, F.S., creates the trust fund, provides revenue sources for the fund, and defines the uses of the fund.

Sections 154.03, 154.05, 154.06, 381.0063, 381.0065, 381.0072, 381.0084, 381.0087, 403.860, 403.862, 513.045, 513.055, 514.033, and 514.05, F.S., creates revenue sources for the fund.

**2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:**

The fund tracks receipts and expenditures associated with the operation of the County Health Departments in providing public health services throughout the state.

**3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:**

The major sources of revenue for the fund are federal grants, private sector grants, a variety of state funds (e.g. general revenue, tobacco, fees and fines), and local contributions. According to Comptroller data, receipts to this fund for FY 1998-99 were \$675,807,408.72.

**B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:**

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.

**III. FISCAL ANALYSIS & ECONOMIC IMPACT STATEMENT:**

This legislation has no fiscal impact on state agencies or state funds, on local governments as a whole or on the private sector. It simply re-creates, without modification, an existing state trust fund and continues the current use of the fund.
