I. <u>SUMMARY</u>:

This legislation re-creates the Donations Trust Fund without modification, effective November 4, 2000. The Donations Trust Fund, FLAIR #64-2-168, is administered by the Department of Health. This fund was last re-created effective November 4,1996, by Chapter 96-111, Laws of Florida.

 - 1. MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The fund is used to budget Children's Medical Services' federal Part C dollars, federal Medicaid match for children's intervention services.

3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The major sources of revenue for the fund are the federal Part C grant, infant screening funds, federal match, and other third party earnings. According to Comptroller data, receipts to this fund for FY 1998-1999 were \$13,731,523.87.

B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.

III. FISCAL ANALYSIS & ECONOMIC IMPACT STATEMENT:

This legislation has no fiscal impact on state agencies or state funds, on local governments as a whole or on the private sector. It simply re-creates, without modification, an existing state trust fund and continues the current use of the fund.
